
Protect Your Home from Wildfire



- Clear flammable vegetation up to 30 feet away from your house.
- Cut lower branches of trees 7-10 feet off the ground.
- Keep the lawn watered and mowed short.
- Clean leaf & needle fall that accumulates.
- Relocate woodpiles (firewood) at least 30 feet from structures.

- Clean the roof, gutters, and windowsills of leaves, needles, and other debris.
- Trim tree branches within 15 feet of the chimney.
- Clear the view of your house number and mailbox so emergency crews can see the 911 address & house number.
- Trim all tree branches overhanging the house.
- Trim tree branches overhanging the driveway to a 14-foot vertical clearance for emergency vehicles.
- Clear all deadwood and dense flammable vegetation within the 30-foot defensible space.
